VISIONS OF CULLEN PARK UPDATES

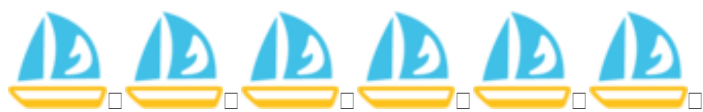
Our guest at the August meeting was Rick Akemam, Manager of Parks. Several pending subjects were discussed, addressed and implemented: The waterfront at the park was cleared of overgrowth affording a vista of the ships, boats and the water. Due to the heavy volume of visitors and use of the Porta potty, a second one was installed. They are usually removed in October. The crummy trash cans have been replaced. A lot accomplished!

There have been 3 Bass tourneys held at the park...the last one will be Sept. 9. ORKA is doing a cleanup on the 8th.

Two loads of rocks and boulders have been brought in to address the erosion problem along the Summit St. Sidewalk between the park and lighthouse near the Westernmost Point of Lake Erie sign. This was brought up several months ago when people were noticing the erosion and exposed conduit. Recent storms have contributed to the situation.
