The Legacy Community Foundation was founded in 2005 and is a 501(c)3 tax qualified charitable foundation intended to improve the quality of life in the Point Place/Shoreland areas. On June 1, 2014, the "Anchors of the Community Memorial" was formally dedicated. Community fund raising and generous contributions from our Business Association and local citizens provided the funding for the project. The Anchor Memorial Committee has just completed its third installation of bricks at the Memorial by the Point Place Lighthouse.
